

Discipline Hearing Summary- Guntis Obrascovs

At a hearing on August 27, 2020, a Panel of the Discipline Committee found registrant Guntis Obrascovs guilty of professional misconduct.

The allegations were as follows:

 The registrant failed to comply with the Quality Assurance Program and failed to reply appropriately within a reasonable time to written inquiries or requests from the College.

Penalty

The Panel ordered:

- 1. The registrant to be reprimanded by the Panel following the hearing.
- 2. The Registrar to suspend the registrant's certificate of registration for a period of no less than five months, beginning on a date to be selected by the Registrar. The suspension remains in effect until the registrant completes condition listed in paragraph 3(a) below.
- 3. The Registrar to immediately impose the following specified terms, conditions and limitations on the registrant's certificate of registration, all of which are to be completed at his own expense and within three months of the date of the Order:
 - a. Requiring the registrant to comply with any outstanding requirements of the College's Quality Assurance Program;
 - b. Requiring the registrant to successfully complete, to the satisfaction of the Registrar and at his own expense, a pre-approved ethics course; and
 - c. Requiring the registrant to review all written College standards and provide written confirmation of review to the Registrar.
- 4. The registrant to pay \$6,500 in costs to the College within one month of the date of the Order. The Registrar can impose an installment plan to ensure regular and consistent payment of the costs.
