

Discipline hearing summary- Moira Swain

At a hearing on January 24, 2020, a Panel of the Discipline Committee found registrant Moira Swain guilty of professional misconduct.

The allegations were as follows:

- 1. Submitting false and/or misleading claims to Sun Life Financial that listed the registrant as the treatment provider and included the registrant's registration number.
- 2. Creating false and/or misleading invoices that listed the registrant as the treatment provider and included the registrant's registration number.
- 3. Failed to ensure that fees charged accurately reflected the services provided and failed to keep proper records for three patients.

Penalty

The Panel ordered:

- 1. The registrant to appear before a Panel of the Discipline Committee to be reprimanded.
- 2. The registrant to successfully complete with an unconditional pass, at her own expense and within 12 months of the date the Order is imposed, the ProBE Program on Professional/Problem-Based Ethics for health care professionals offered by the Centre for Personalized Education for Physicians, or complete another educational program as agreed with the College.
- 3. The Registrar to suspend the registrant's certificate of registration for a period of eight months. The suspension period can be reduced by one month if the registrant completes the above-noted program within seven months.
- 4. The registrant to pay the College \$1,000 in costs within 120 days of the date the Order is imposed.
- 5. The Finding and the Order of the Discipline Committee to be published in detail or in summary with the registrant's name, online and/or in print, including, but not limited to the College's official publications and on the College's website.
